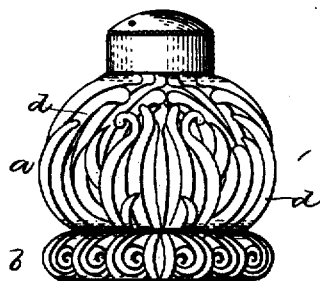

## DESIGN FOR A CONDIMENT-HOLDER.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 27,132, dated June 1, 1897.

Application filed March 13, 1897. Serial No. 627,435. Term of patent 3½ years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ROBERT HUNTER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rochester, in the county of Beaver and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for a Condiment-Holder or Similar Article; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the invention, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which it appertains to make and use the same.

This invention has relation to designs for hollow articles, such as condiment-holders; and it consists in the shape and configuration herein shown and described.

In the accompanying drawing the figure is a side view or elevation of an article of table-ware embracing my design.

The shape of the article is a conventional representation of the "chrysanthemum" flower, and comprises the bulbous body portion *a* and base *b*, upon which appear in relief and intermingling curves the leaves *d d*. The order and pattern in which the leaves are arranged may be varied without departing from the essential features of the design.

Having described my invention, I claim—  
The design for a condiment-holder herein shown and described.
