

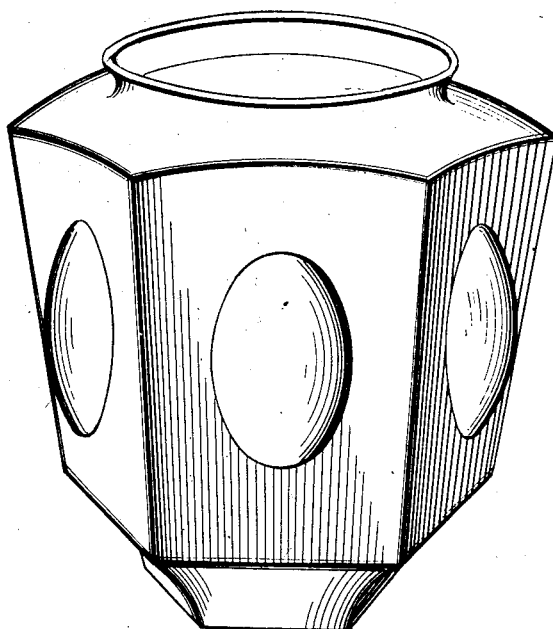

DESIGN FOR A GLASS GLOBE.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE F. WEHR, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rochester, in the county of Beaver and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for Glass Globes, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure of the drawing is a perspective view of a globe showing my new design.

The salient or distinctive features of the design are the shape and surface ornamentation of the globe, the latter being of trun-

cated, polygonal, pyramidal form with the base convex and merged into a central neck and the narrowed end surmounted by or contracted abruptly to form slightly concave facets. The panels or sides of the body are formed with oval convex projections.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a glass globe, as shown and described.
