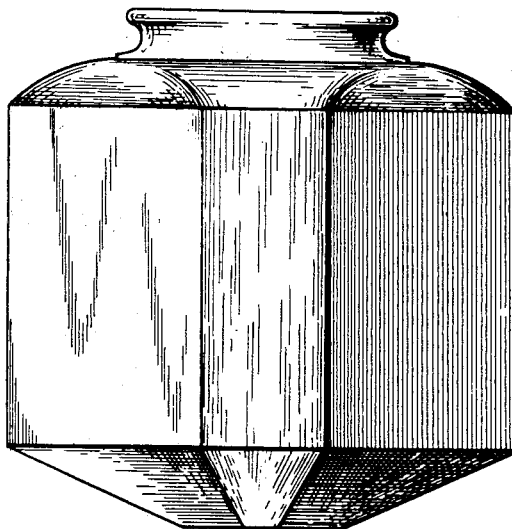
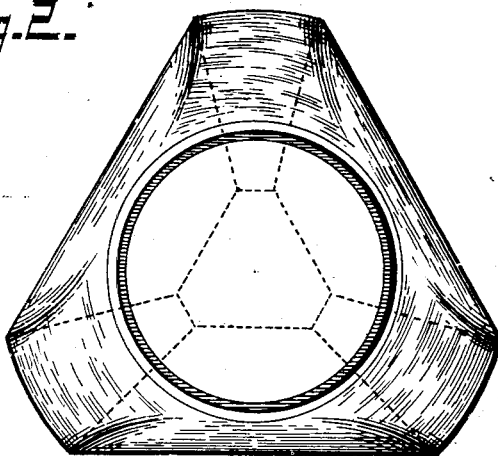

DESIGN FOR A GLOBE FOR LIGHTING FIXTURES.

Application filed February 9, 1922. Serial No. 615. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS KOPP, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Globe for Lighting Fixtures, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of the globe showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a top view thereof.
