

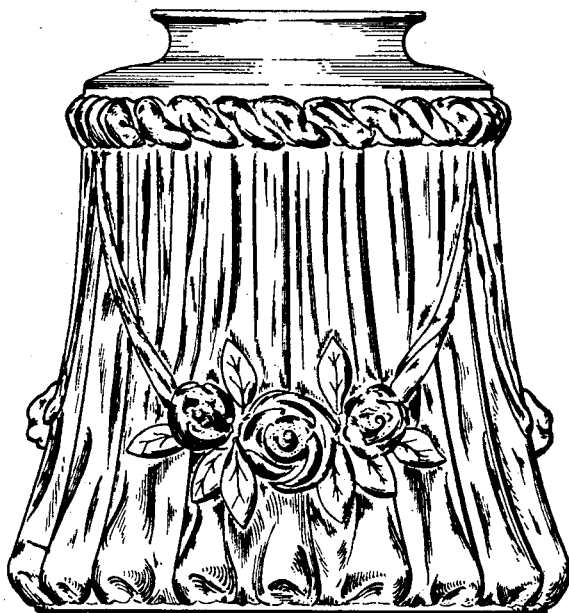

DESIGN FOR A SHADE FOR LIGHTING FIXTURES.

Application filed August 25, 1922. Serial No. 3,553. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:
