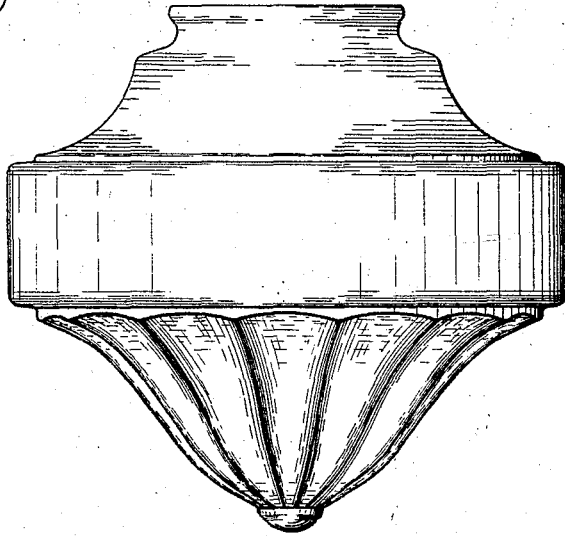
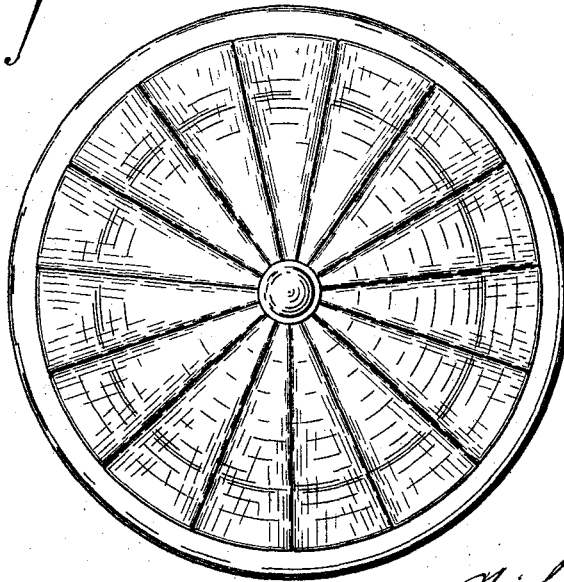

DESIGN FOR AN ILLUMINATING GLOBE.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS KOPP, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Illuminating Globe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
