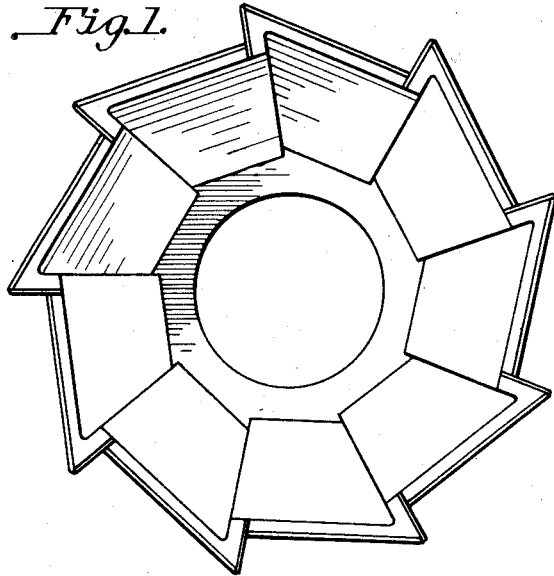
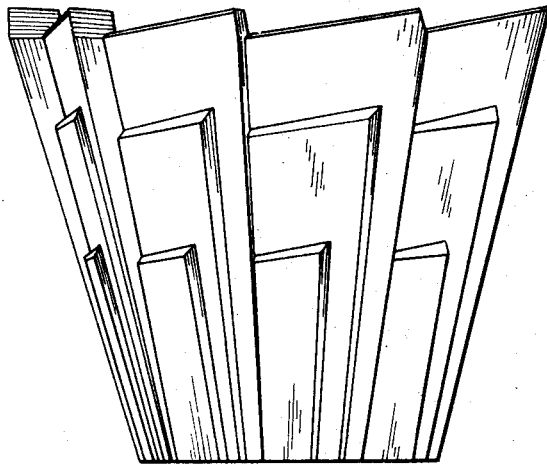

DESIGN FOR A GLOBE FOR ILLUMINATING FIXTURES.

Application filed March 12, 1929. Serial No. 30,444. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS KOPP, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Globe for Illuminating Fixtures, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
