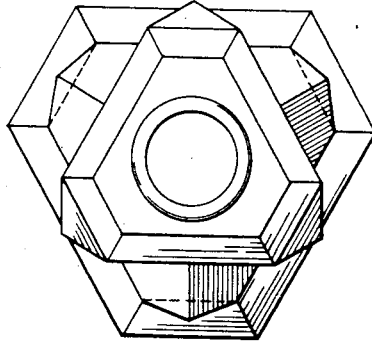
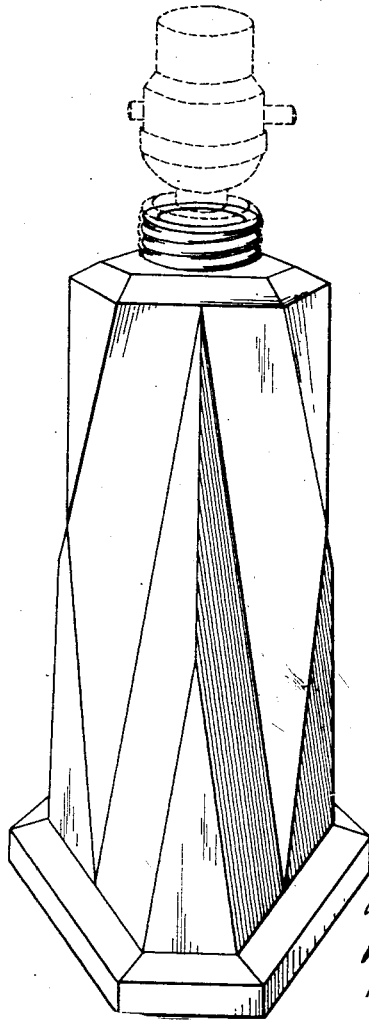

DESIGN FOR A LAMP STANDARD.

Application filed January 4, 1929. Serial No. 29,504. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS KOPP, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny, and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lamp Standard, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof:
