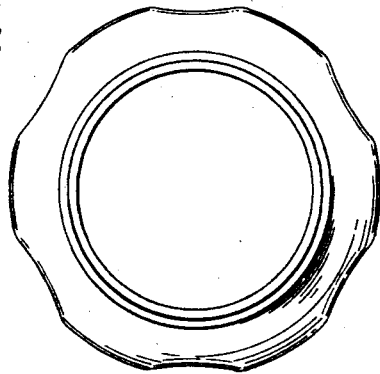

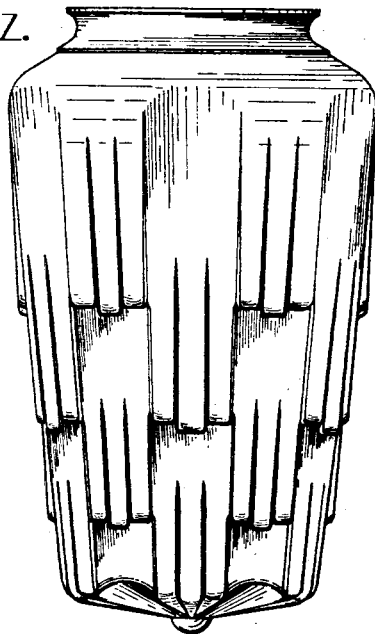
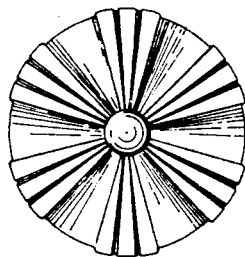

DESIGN FOR A LIGHTING-FIXTURE BOWL OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed August 24, 1929. Serial No. 32,532. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS KOPP, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lighting-Fixture Bowl or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is an elevational view of a lighting fixture bowl or similar article, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view; and

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a lighting fixture bowl or similar article, as shown.
