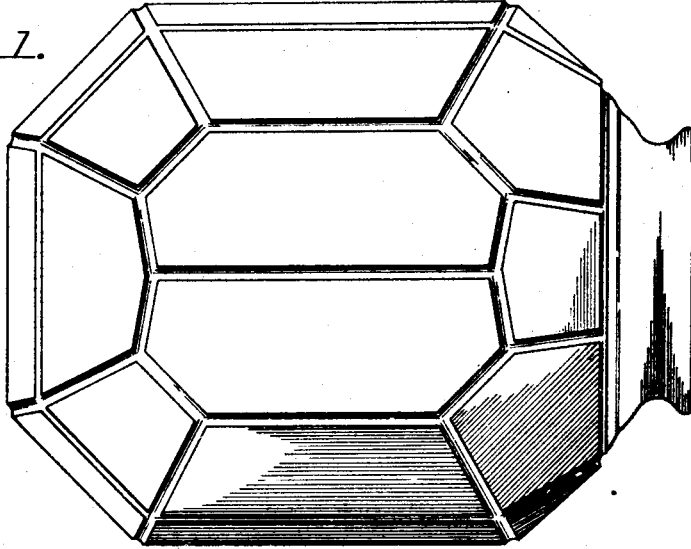

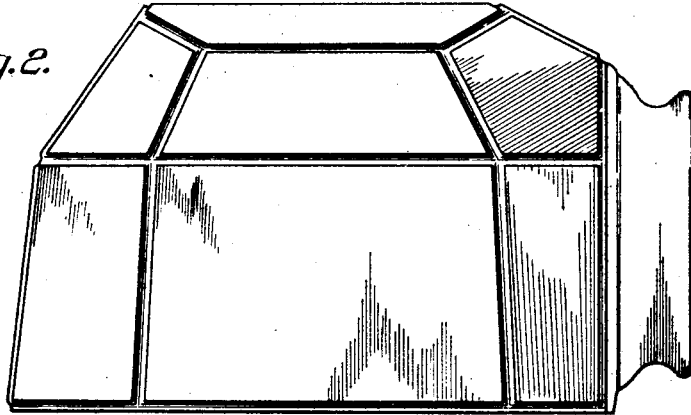
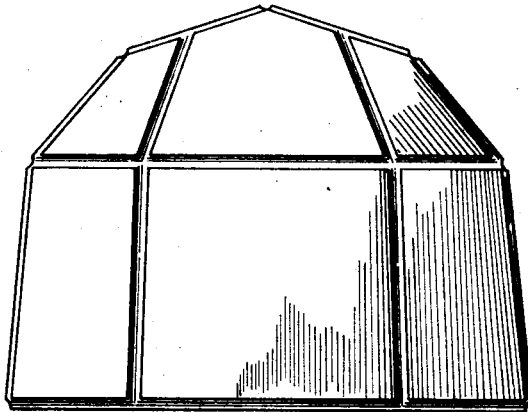

DESIGN FOR A LIGHT SHADE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed December 22, 1930. Serial No. 38,071. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS KOPP, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Light Shade or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a light shade or similar article, showing my new design; Fig. 2 a side elevational view; and Fig. 3 an end elevational view thereof.
