

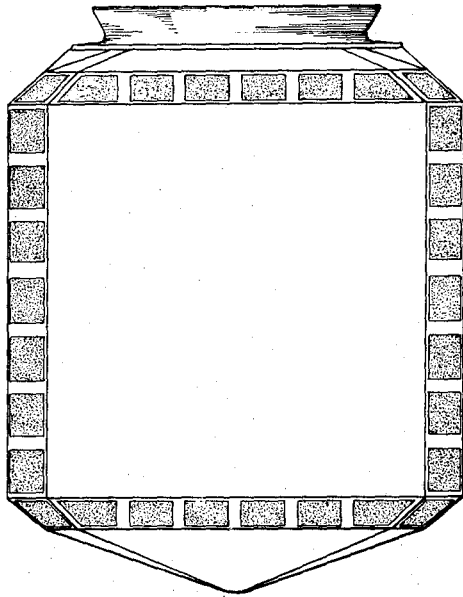

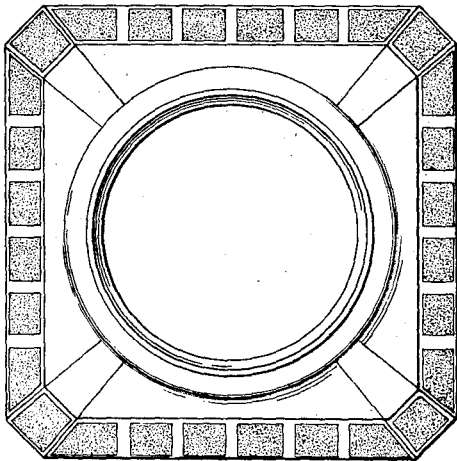

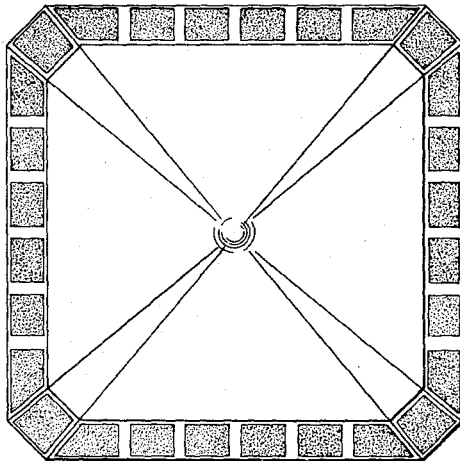

### DESIGN FOR AN ADVERTISING SIGN

Application filed April 2, 1931. Serial No. 39,341. Term of patent 7 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, NICHOLAS KOPP, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Advertising Sign, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
