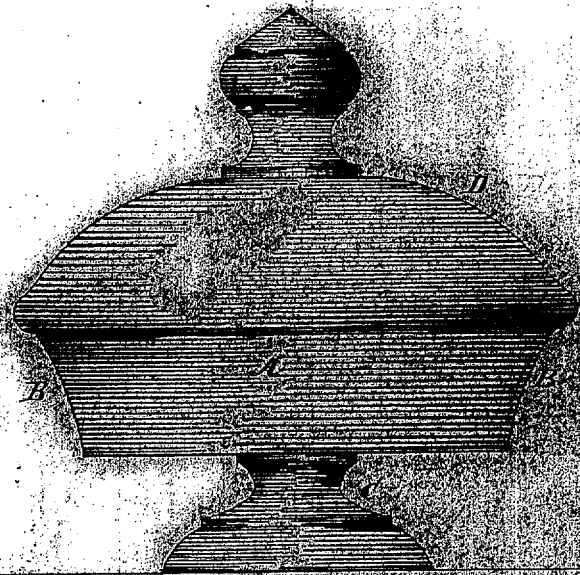

JAMES HOBBS, OF BELLAIRE, OHIO.

DESIGN FOR GLASS DISHES AND NAPPIES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **6,587**, dated April 15, 1873; application filed April 3, 1873.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES HOBBS, of Bellaire, in the county of Belmont and State of Ohio, have invented a Design for Pressed-Glass Dishes and Nappies, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photo-lithographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents the body of a round or oval pressed glass-dish with concave sides B, which constitute my invention. This dish may, if desired, be provided with a foot, C, and cover

D, but I shall generally make them without either.

I am aware that dishes with straight and with oval sides are not new, and I do not claim them; but

What I do claim as my invention is—

The design of a pressed-glass dish with concave sides, substantially as above described.
